Parking

- CBI has two small parking areas: an outdoor parking lot and an underground parking garage.
- Our outdoor lot is at the corner of NW 19th and NW Flanders Streets; to access the Main Sanctuary, Schnitzer Family Center, Sherman Education Building, or The Jennifer Barnum Luria Early Childhood Center, proceed west (toward NW 20th St) along NE Flanders Street.
- The entrance to our **parking garage** is on NW Flanders on the south side of the Schnitzer Family Center, just across from our domed Main Sanctuary.
 - Ring the bell at the clearly-marked garage call box and staff will admit you.
 - You will need to ring a second bell for entry to the building itself after you have parked.

Visitors the Main Sanctuary

- Our Main Sanctuary is a large ,domed, brick building located on the north side of Flanders Street between NW 19th and NW 20th Streets.
- This building is locked when not in use for holiday observances, Shabbat services, B'nei Mitzvah, and other community gatherings.
- When the Sanctuary is open, CBI staff members and volunteer greeters can direct you the the proper door, as well as help you find a seat in our pews, get settled with prayer books, and answer any questions you may have.

Visitors to the Schnitzer Family Center

- The Schnitzer Family Center is located on the south side of Flanders Street between NW 19th and NW 20th Streets.
- Our Main Office, Pollin Chapel, and Goodman Hall are located in this building.
 - Our office is on the second floor, and accessible via elevator or stairs.
- For the vast majority of gatherings, you will use the glass doors, pictured below.
- During office hours, you will need to be buzzed in via intercom to access the building; for holidays, services, and Religious School, a CBI staff member will monitor the door.

Visitors to the Sherman Education Building and Jennifer Barnum Luria Early Childhood Center

- Opposite the historic Temple, the Sherman Education Building houses the Congregation's URJ-accredited Religious School, as well as the Jennifer Barnum Luria Early Childhood Center.
- Access to this building is available for CBI and The Jennie students, family, and staff during school hours only.
 - During Religious School hours, parents, students, and community members may access this building via doors on NW Flanders, which are monitored by CBI Staff.
 - During the school week, students and families at The Jennie via the entrance at 482 NW 20th Avenue (near the corner of NW 20th and NW Glisan Streets).
 - Ring the intercom at that location and a staff person will let you in.
